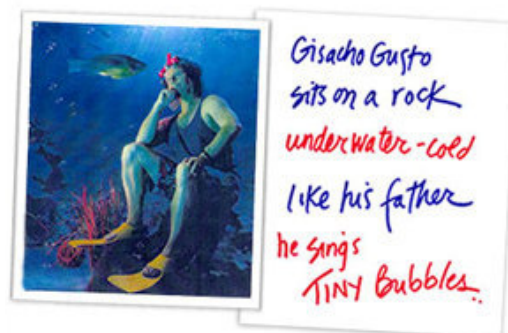


TimeSlips Training Workshop in Greensboro, NC

TimeSlips is an innovative and effective group storytelling method that helps people with dementia reaffirm their humanity and connect with staff, family and friends. The method replaces the pressure to remember with the encouragement to imagine. Facilitators guide the storytelling session by asking open-ended questions, listening intently, writing down all responses, and weaving them together by repeating the story as it grows. The method values the unique voice of individual participants, their heritage, perspective, and present level of ability. This program is stimulating and fun, creating an environment where all responses are accepted and elders feel safe to participate.



The TimeSlips Project has generated hundreds of stories, produced plays and art exhibits, and rekindled the hope for human connection among people living with Alzheimer's Disease and related dementia.
